A Brief History of our Field Survey

After a long declaration of Covid Pandemic
College was re-opened and the Dept. of History of
Bimandi Chandra Medhi College, Ramdia decided to
visit the nearest chare (Island) Sialmari. The DAC
of the History Department allowed to visit the
area. The date had fixed on 1st Feb/2022. The
aim of the trip was field Survey on Socio-Economic
Condition of the Sialmari chare (Island)

We began our journey at 8.00 A.M.
on 1st Feb/2022 from our college. The day was
Tuesday. There were 15 (Fifteen) Students and
1 (one) Teacher as a guide. After reaching our
destination at about 9.30 A.M had our breakfast.
After breakfast we started our work accordingly.
I noted down some of the important points of
our field Survey.

The chare (Island) is situated in be-
tween Kamrup and Nalbari Districts. There is
no any permanent road to communicate with
the chare (Island). Most of the people belongs to
Religious Minority Caste. The main occupation
of the people of Sialmari chare (Island) is cultiv-
ation. A few portion they are engaged
with weaving.



From beginning to end of the

trips. Students observed the Socio-Economic Condition of the People of the Particular area. We visited Cultivated field, Police Station, Riverside Public Health Centre (Kudikamari char) Schools and the Local People houses.

Outcome of the Field Survey.

- ① Students got to know about the Historical Significance of the area.


