MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

Tool Room & Training Centre, Guwahati
MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISES, GOVT. OF INDIA

AND

Binandi Chandra Medhi College, Ramdia, Kamrup

FOR

**SKILL DEVELOPMENT, TRAINING OF STUDENTS AND FACULTY, AND JOINT
COLLABORATION THROUGH INDUSTRY-RELEVANT PROJECTS AND CONSULTANCY
SERVICES**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU") is entered into on this 18/05/2026:

BETWEEN

Binandi Chandra Medhi College, Ramdia, Kamrup, Pin- 781102, represented by its Principal Dr. Biswajit Das, hereinafter referred to as the "First Party".

AND

Tool Room & Training Centre, Guwahati, under Ministry of MSME, Government of India, Amingaon Industrial Area, North Guwahati Road, Guwahati-781031, Assam, represented by Shri Jajati Kesharee Mohanty, Project Manager, hereinafter referred to as the "Second Party".

(Collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party")


CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

1. Both Parties agree to establish communication and cooperation channels to advance mutual goals in technical education, industry exposure, and capacity building.
2. The collaboration will include the use of intellectual capabilities and infrastructure of both institutions to enhance skill development initiatives aligned with industrial demands.
3. This MoU shall serve as a framework for cooperation, and the Parties shall enter into further definitive documents if required to implement specific projects or initiatives under this MoU.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

4. Skill Enhancement of Students: Focused programs and projects will be undertaken to prepare students for the industry with practical knowledge and exposure.

5. Curriculum Development: The Second Party will assist the First Party in improving its curriculum and teaching methodology to align with current industrial needs.
6. Industrial Training & Visits: The Second Party will facilitate industrial training, lab visits, and real-time exposure for students and faculty of the First Party.
7. Internship Support: The Second Party will provide internship opportunities to students of the First Party.
8. Joint Research Projects: Both Parties shall collaborate on joint research and innovation projects in their areas of expertise.
9. Skill Development Programmes: Second Party will offer short-term and long-term skill development programs for students of the First Party in emerging technologies.
10. Guest Lectures: Second Party will provide expert faculty/industry professionals for delivering guest lectures on latest technological trends.
11. Faculty Development: Training programs, workshops, and seminars will be conducted for faculty of the First Party, leveraging the expertise and infrastructure of the Second Party.
12. Approvals and Permissions: Both Parties shall ensure all necessary approvals and permissions are obtained to offer training and programs under this MoU.
13. No Financial Commitment: This MoU does not impose any financial obligation on either Party for the activities proposed unless mutually agreed upon in writing.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY


14. This MoU does not grant either Party any rights, titles, or licenses to the intellectual property of the other Party, except where explicitly agreed upon in writing.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

15. This MoU shall remain valid for a period of two (2) years from the date of signing, unless terminated earlier by mutual consent or by providing a 30-day written notice by either Party.
16. Upon termination, both Parties shall fulfill any pending obligations under this MoU.


CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

17. Both Parties shall act as independent entities. This MoU does not create a legal partnership or agency relationship between the Parties.
18. Neither Party shall use the other's name or create any obligation on behalf of the other without prior written consent.
19. Any dispute arising from the interpretation or execution of this MoU shall be resolved through arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The place of arbitration shall be at the district headquarters of the First Party, and jurisdiction shall lie exclusively with the Courts of Amingaon, Kamrup (Assam).
